



CODE OF UNIFORM SAFETY RULES

USR-01 Speeding

All persons traveling the private road system at Desert Mountain must obey the posted speed limit. The Village speed limit is 20 MPH unless posted differently. The speed limit on all other roads is as posted. Any person exceeding the posted speed limit is in violation of this guideline.

Excessive Speed is defined as 20 MPH over the posted speed limit. Any person traveling 20 MPH or greater over the posted speed limit shall be cited for Excessive Speeding.

Note: This table depicts only monetary fines when applicable, in some cases, criminal trespass, or restricted access to property, or site closures may also be imposed as part of the violation

Members / Guest / Visitors / Renters-

If the violator is a guest, visitor or renter of a member/resident, the member/resident is also sent a copy of the violation. If the guest/visitor requests an appeal, the member/resident is notified and must appear with the violator. If a fine is imposed, the member is responsible for payment. Renters are categorized as guest of owners.

Desert Mountain Club Employees –

Copies of violation notices issued to Desert Mountain Club employees are routed to the Human Resources Department for appropriate disciplinary action that may include suspension and or termination.

Employees may have driving and access privileges' restricted by the Association.

All Others –

Access to the community is immediately restricted if speeding violation fines are not paid within fifteen (15) business days.

A hearing with the covenants Committee is mandatory upon a third offense of these penalties.

Penalties for Non Payment of Fines – USRs and Fine Collection

A Board Resolution approved the following recommendations to collect unpaid fines:

1. USR-01 Speeding is amended to categorized renters as guest of owners.
2. Owners that are subject to being fined for this violation and have not requested an appeal in the allocated time frame shall be mailed a notification letter. The letter will inform them of the amount of the fine and beginning / ending dates of their ego tag suspension. Suspension of the ego tag will begin five business days from the date on the letter.
3. Vendors, contractors, service providers may be refused entry into Desert Mountain if fines are not paid. If their vehicle has an eGo tag assigned to it, the same procedure will apply to suspension of their tag.
